
WE HAD A CHANCE TO SPEND SOME TIME IN HELSINKI TWO YEARS ago hosted by the city and came away enormously impressed. We were struck by its beauty and grace, the celebration of its spectacular natural setting, the generosity and care given to maintaining its public spaces, its walkability and commitment to inclusion in its neighbourhoods. Quality design and the presence of arts and culture were everywhere evident from the smallest details to architecture and city form.

We are in the midst of a major shift in the life of our cities, growing vertically, getting denser and learning how to live together at closer quarters, dealing with issues of affordability, congestion, climate readiness, how to provide and maintain great public spaces and social service for the whole population. We have lots to figure out and are learning from each other as cities around the world make these adjustments and respond to new challenges. Helsinki exhibited an inventiveness in facing these challenges and an embrace of the future informed by a human-centred urbanism with a commitment to social equity, public education and life in public that resonated with us. Despite many very significant differences there seemed to be significant shared values with Canadian cities and our own city Toronto that made us feel that there was much more to learn and understand that would be inspirational in our own efforts.

This tour has been designed to provide the opportunity to dive more deeply with a chance to meet local people and experience neighbourhood and city life firsthand. You will visit places of culture, business and recreation, explore the city on foot and on transit, and meet with many people who are making a difference. These individuals are in government, in the private sector, or are citizens and NGOs. They are individually and collectively shaping buildings and neighbourhoods, building remarkable new structures and urban spaces, revitalizing older areas, and creating new ones. We will about hear their experiences and get some sense of what it might be like to live there, learn about both successes and challenges, and the lessons learned in wrestling with issues like housing affordability and integration of newcomers, mobility and congestion, and innovations in dealing with waste, energy and climate change.

We are all participating in a collective learning curve and no one city has a monopoly on the answers. But we are inspired by the ways we see how others tackle similar issues to reflect on our own places practices and see and how we might do better. Finally there is the sheer pleasure of experiencing city life off the beaten tourist path at close quarters in another environment, the sights, the sounds, the tastes and the feeling of being in unique city like Helsinki. We hope you will consider joining us on this voyage of discovery.

Detailed Itinerary

Saturday, Aug. 15: Arrive in Helsinki

Welcome to Helsinki! Participants will be met on arrival and transferred to our city centre hotel. Meet with Ken, Eti, and fellow travellers for a briefing and introductory seminar this afternoon, followed by dinner together with views over Helsinki's bustling seafront market.

Sunday, Aug. 16: Public spaces, shared services

Get to know Helsinki on a guided walking tour focussing on the these of the use of public space. During our walk, we'll see the new Oodi Library, the Musiikkitalo concert hall, the Kiasma Modern Art Museum, and the subterranean Amos Rex museum expansion. This afternoon head to Vallisaari Island to experience the outstanding Finnish and international art at the Helskinki Biennial.

Monday, Aug. 17: Mixed-income neighbourhoods

Today we explore one of the new districts of Helsinki; the Jätkäsaari-Ruoholahti neighbourhood. We'll be examining themes of 'carless blocks', the expansion of transit and active transportation, strategies for mixed income in new neighbourhoods within individual blocks, and the provision of local services to meet the needs of mixed neighbourhoods. Take in an afternoon presentation by an urban planner addressing these issues.

Tuesday, Aug. 18: Saunas, active transportation

This morning's guided walking tour takes us to the Vuosaari neighbourhood exploring the themes of the changing relationship of living and working in mixed-use settings and how this is expressed in the evolution of the block pattern from closed courtyards to shared open courtyards. This afternoon drive just out of town to Nuuksio National Park for a Finnish forest experience. Enjoy a short hike in the forest with a nature guide, then enjoy a true Finnish sauna experience by the lake. After the sauna, enjoy dinner in the Lappish style kota around an open fire. Overnight: Hotel Katajonakka, Helsinki

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Wednesday, Aug. 19: Integrating new technologies

Get out on a walking tour of the Kalasatama neighbourhood with a specialist architecture guide. Owing to good transport connections, the area has thousands of jobs, and the redevelopment will bring many new offices and new commercial space to the area. The new residential blocks will offer versatile housing alternatives. The shoreline and canals will be lined by a long promenade. A former power plant in adjacent Suvilahti turned into a cultural centre adds to the charm of the area. Overnight: Hotel Katajonakka, Helsinki

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Thursday, Aug. 20: Role of public education

This morning, we visit a secondary school to consider the critical role of public education in Finland. A special presentation on the role of education and meetings with teachers rounds out our morning. This afternoon head back to the Helskinki Biennial. Overnight: Hotel Katajonakka, Helsinki

Friday, Aug. 21: Excursion to Tallinn

The Estonian city of Tallinn lies almost directly across the Gulf of Finland. It's splendidly photogenic; the walled city looks over the Baltic Sea and its medieval streets are lined with gabled merchants' houses, churches, and classical buildings. We'll take the two-hour ferry trip to Tallinn and enjoy a guided walk in the Upper Town to see the Russian Orthodox Cathedral with its profusion of onion domes and many fine historic buildings including the 15th century Town Hall, the Parliament building set in the remains of Toompea Castle and the 12th century Saint Olav's church, once the tallest structure in the world! Return to Helsinki this evening. *Overnight: Hotel Katajonakka, Helsinki Meals: Breakfast*

Saturday, Aug. 22: Mixed use settings

The full day is yours to revisit a favourite site or discover something new before dinner together on a traditional summer island restaurant.

Overnight: Helsinki Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Sunday, Aug. 23: Depart Helsinki

After breakfast cruise to Patara, Turkey's longest beach, overlooked After breakfast today, we are transferred to the airport for homeward-bound flights.

What to Expect

Joining Instructions

This tour begins with our briefing at 5PM on August 15th. Please ensure that you arrive in Helsinki by 3PM to join the group. All travellers arriving on the start date of the tour will be met on arrival and transferred to the group hotel. This transfer is included in the cost of the tour. When you book the designated pre-trip accommodation with Worldwide Quest, your transfer from the airport to our group hotel on arrival is included. If you are making your own pre-trip arrangements, this transfer can be provided at additional cost. The tour concludes with a single complimentary transfer from the hotel to the airport on August 23rd. Please contact us to verify timing of this transfer prior to making any flight arrangements.

Level of Activity: Moderate

A good level of fitness is important for this trip. You must be comfortable walking on uneven terrain and irregular paving for at least two hours at a stretch. We will be using public transit for most of our activities in Helsinki.

Accommodation

Hotel Katajanokka is a historic 170 years old former prison, now transformed into a first-class hotel. Located in Helsinki centre in the historic Katajanokka district, by the sea, the hotel has 106 rooms, as well as restaurant and bar services, conference facilities, and an idyllic summer terrace.



Transportation

We will be using public transit for most of our activities in Helsinki.

Weather

We expect a mix of sun and cloud with average daytime temperatures of 20°C and overnight temperatures of about 14°C.

Travel Documents

You will require a passport for this trip. Please ensure it is valid for at least 6 months beyond your scheduled return home. Canadian and USA passport-holders do not require a visa for travel to Finland.
